

Grant Title: AMERICAN-SCANDINAVIAN FOUNDATION VISITING LECTURESHIP

Funding Opportunity Number: N/A

Agency/Department: The American-Scandinavian Foundation

Area of Research: Host a visiting lecturer from Norway or Sweden.

Release and Expiration: N/A

Application Deadline: February 5, 2010. Letter of intent deadline: November 6, 2009.

Amount: \$20,000 teaching/research stipend; \$5,000 travel stipend for lecture appearances outside home institution; J-1 visa sponsorship as a short-term scholar (up to 6 months) through the ASF Visitor Exchange Program.

Length of Support: One semester.

Eligible Applicants: Awards are given to non-profit organizations only. The competition is open to all American colleges and universities. The award is appropriate not just for Scandinavian studies departments, but for any department or inter-disciplinary program with an interest in incorporating a Scandinavian focus into its course offerings.

Summary: The ASF invites U.S. colleges and universities to apply for funding to host a visiting lecturer from Norway or Sweden. Lectureships should be in the areas of: public policy, conflict resolution, health care, environmental studies or multiculturalism. The lecturer must be a Norwegian or Swedish citizen, and a scholar or expert in a field appropriate to the host department or program. The ASF encourages consideration of the practitioner as well as the academic as a lectureship candidate.
