Agency/Department: Department of Education, Institute of Education Sciences.

Area of Research: Design, develop, and implement statewide, longitudinal data systems.

Release and Expiration: Release Date: July 31, 2009.

Application Deadline: The deadline has been extended to December 4, 2009. The previous deadline was November 19, 2009.

Amount: Grants will range from \$2,000,000 to \$20,000,000 for the entire project period.

Length of Support: Not to exceed 3 years.

Eligible Applicants: Eligible applicants are limited to SEAs.

Summary: The purpose of assistance under this program is to enable State educational agencies to design, develop, and implement statewide, longitudinal data systems to efficiently and accurately manage, analyze, disaggregate and use individual student data. The goal of the program is to enable all States to create comprehensive systems that permit the generation and use of accurate and timely data, support informed decision making at all levels of the education system, increase the efficiency with which data may be analyzed to support the continuous improvement of education services and outcomes, facilitate research to improve student achievement and close achievement gaps, and support education accountability systems and public reporting.
