

Grant Title: WOMEN HELPING OTHERS (WHO) FOUNDATION EDUCATION/LITERACY GRANTS

Funding Opportunity Number: N/A

Agency/Department: WHO Foundation

Area of Research: Support free after school organizations and for the implementation or expansion of education and/or literacy programs for low-income children of all ages.

Release and Expiration: N/A

Application Deadline: Annually in March.

Amount: Maximum Award: Up to \$5000.

Length of Support: One year.

Eligible Applicants: In order to qualify for funding, an organization must have 501(c)(3) non-profit status through the U.S. Internal Revenue Service and be qualified to receive deductible charitable contributions. Organizations must have been incorporated for a minimum of three years prior to application. Preference will be given to organizations with an operating budget of \$3 million or less, those not dependent upon government grants, and those with greater organizational program costs than personnel costs.

Summary: WHO Foundation Education/Literacy grants provide funding to 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations in the United States and Puerto Rico to support free after school organizations and for the implementation or expansion of education and/or literacy programs for low-income children of all ages. In order to qualify for funding, an organization must have been incorporated for a minimum of 3 years prior to application.
