

**Grant Title:** ACADEMIC CAREER AWARD (K07)

**Funding Opportunity Number:** CFDA Number(s): 93.213, 93.272. Funding Opportunity Number: PA-09-041.

**Agency/Department:** Department of Health and Human Services, National Institutes of Health (NIH), National Institute on Aging (NIA), National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism (NIAAA), National Center for Complementary and Alternative Medicine (NCCAM), Office of Dietary Supplements (ODS).

**Area of Research:** Provides support to enhance the educational or research capacity.

**Release and Expiration:** Release Date: December 11, 2008. Expiration Date: January 8, 2012.

**Application Deadline:** New: February 12, June 12, October 12. For Renewal, Resubmission, or Revision: March 12, July 12, November 12.

**Amount:** Because the nature and scope of the proposed K07 award program will vary from application to application and the amounts provided by the participating ICs are not uniform, it is anticipated that the size and duration of each award will also vary.

**Length of Support:** Up to five years (at least three years are required for the K07 Development award, and at least two years are required for the K07 Leadership award).

**Eligible Applicants:** Public and State controlled institutions of higher education. See the full announcement for a complete list of eligible applicants.

**Summary:** The purpose of the NIH Academic Career Award (K07) is to provide support to increase the pool of individuals with academic and research expertise to become academic researchers and to enhance the educational or research capacity at the grantee sponsoring grantee institution. The Academic Career Award supports K07 Development awards for more junior level candidates and K07 Leadership awards for more senior individuals with acknowledged scientific expertise and leadership skills.
