Eligible Applicants: Career Development Grants are open to women who: are U.S. citizens or permanent residents; hold an earned (not honorary) bachelor's degree; as of July 1, 2009, received their most recent degree on or before June 30, 2004; plan to enroll in courses/activities that are required for professional employment or advancement; and plan to enroll in one of the following: 1) Bachelor's or associate's degree that is different from the field of study of the previously earned bachelor's degree; 2) Master's degree; 3) Certification program; 4) Technical school; 5) Professional degree; 6) Doctoral degree, other than Ph.D.

Agency/Department: American Association of University Women (AAUW)

Summary: Career Development Grants support women who hold a bachelor's degree and are preparing to advance their careers, change careers, or re-enter the work force. Special consideration is given to women of color, and women pursuing their first advanced degree or credentials in nontraditional fields. Grants provide support for course work beyond a bachelor's degree, including a master's degree, second bachelor's degree, or specialized training in technical or professional fields. Funds are available for distance learning. Course work must be taken at an accredited two- or four-year college or university in the United States, or at a technical school that is fully licensed or accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. Funds are not available for PhD-level work.
