

Grant Title: NIDCD SMALL GRANT PROGRAM

Grant Number: PAR-07-287

Area of Research: Deafness and communication disorders.

Release and Expiration: January 9, 2007 release; October 30, 2009 expiration.

Application Deadline: March 13, 2007; June 27, 2007; October 29, 2007; February 26, 2008; June 27, 2008; October 29, 2008; February 26, 2009; June 29, 2009; October 29, 2009.

Amount: Up to four modules of \$25,000 each (\$100,000 Direct Costs per year).

Length of Support: Up to 3 years.

Eligible applicants: Public, state, or private institutions of higher education; and nonprofits.

Agency/ Department: NIH; NIDCD

Summary: The Small Grant Program is designed to support basic and clinical research of scientists who are in the early stages of establishing an independent research career. The R03 may be used to support individuals transitioning from postdoctoral status to their first independent research position. The research must be focused on one or more of the areas within the biomedical and behavioral scientific mission of the NIDCD: hearing, balance, smell, taste, voice, speech or language.
