

Treatment Integrity Measure for the Behavior Strategies:

Steps to follow:	Yes or No Response:
Have desirable behaviors been decided upon?	
Have appropriate rules been established? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are rules clear and concise? • Are they posted in a prominent place? • Are there no more than 3-5 rules? • Are the rules positively stated? 	
Is the response to the behavior the same each time? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is appropriate behavior being rewarded? • Is inappropriate behavior being ignored? 	
Is there structure provided in the child's environment? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is there an established routine? • Are there clear expectations of behavior? 	
Are effective commands being presented? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is the child in close proximity? • Was a stern facial expression used? • Was the child's name spoken? • Was eye contact maintained? • Was a firm voice used? • Were direct and simple commands used? • Were appropriate consequences provided when needed? 	
Is appropriate behavior being rewarded by the use of verbal or physical, activity, or tangible rewards?	
Is positive praise being provided? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is the praise immediate? • Is the praise frequent? • Is there eye contact? • Is the praise enthusiastic? • Is the praise descriptive? 	
Is inappropriate behavior being ignored? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is all attention being removed briefly? • Are arguments and scolding being avoided? • Is eye contact being avoided and head turned the other way?
