

Invitation to Participate

You are invited to participate in a research study testing the effects of a program called Teachers and Parents as Partners (TAPP).

What is TAPP?

- TAPP brings parents and teachers together to address behavioral or social concerns that get in the way of student learning.
- School specialists use TAPP to lead parent-teacher meetings, solve problems and assist in developing student behavior plans.

What does participation involve?

Parent participation is completely voluntary. It includes being randomly selected to either participate in TAPP services or to continue with your typical school services.

If selected for TAPP services:

- You will be asked to attend about four meetings with your child's teacher and a school specialist.
- You and your child's teacher will create plans to support your child.
- You will receive up to **\$400** for participation.

If selected for typical services:

- You will not be asked to attend TAPP meetings.
- Your child will continue to receive services provided by the school.
- You will receive up to **\$300** for participation.

ALL parent participants will be asked to:

- Complete 10 brief (five-minute) telephone or text message interviews.
- Complete two online surveys that take approximately 45 minutes each.
- Give permission for your child's teacher to collect eight (30-minute) videos and complete surveys about your child's skills.
